

NAHU Education Foundation Scholarship Award Program



Below is information about the eligibility requirements for the NAHU Education Foundation's ("Sponsor's") personal award scholarship program. Through this program the Sponsor provides awards of \$2000 per year in educational scholarships, in the amount of \$1000 each to two individuals.

- 1) **Eligibility:** The NAHU Education Foundation Scholarship Program is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- a) (1) be 17 to 24 years of age; and
(2) have been affected by the serious illness or disability of a parent/legal guardian; and
(3) be currently enrolled in, or have been accepted to, a college, university or trade school within the fifty (50) United States, the District of Columbia or Puerto Rico.

OR

- b) Applicants may qualify if their field(s) of study in college or a university includes insurance or insurance related coursework.

OR

- c) Applicant or immediate family member had a positive experience with health insurance. Ex: a high dollar claim was paid without delay; there was helpful interaction between an insurer, insurance broker, and the applicant/family member.

OR

- d) Other: tell about any other life experience you feel qualifies you for this scholarship award.

In addition, new or soon-to-be high school graduates must have at least a C+ GPA, and current college students must have at least a C+ grade average.

2) **Application:**

- 1. Applicant must complete the online Biographical Questionnaire no later than the deadlines listed below.
- 2. A current transcript must be submitted with your application.
- 3. A one page single spaced essay or short video discussing why you feel you should be selected for this scholarship.

Additional entry requirements: (1) the application, including the essay or video must be submitted in English; (2) must be the applicant's original work; (3) must be verifiable as created solely by applicant; and (4) must be no restrictions or limitations on the applicant's right to submit, or Sponsor's right to use. In addition, an application and related materials cannot defame or invade publicity rights or privacy rights of any person. Modifying, enhancing or altering a third party's pre-existing work does not qualify as applicant's original creation. An entry may not be offensive or inappropriate, as determined by the Foundation in its sole discretion.

THE ESSAY OR VIDEO MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION AS AN ATTACHMENT OR RELATED MEANS.

Employees and Board members of the NAHU Education Foundation or The National Association of Health Underwriters and their immediate family members are not eligible to apply for or be awarded a scholarship under this program. A minor will be required to have a parent's or legal guardian's permission to apply. Void where prohibited by law. Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.

1. **Awards:** Will be paid directly to accredited US American trade schools, colleges or universities.
2. **Winners:** A winner may decide which semester or quarter he/she wants the tuition applied to.

Application cut-off dates, Semester System:

First Semester: August 12, 2011 – Friday

Second Semester: January 6, 2012 - Friday

Summer Semester: June 8, 2012 - Friday

Application cut off dates, Quarter System:

Fall Quarter: September 9, 2011 - Friday

Winter Quarter: December 16, 2011 – Friday

Spring Quarter: February 24, 2012 – Friday

Summer Quarter: June 12, 2012 – Tuesday

4. **Winner Notification:** Winners will be notified of their award. Winners will be required to execute and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability and Publicity Release within 10 business days of issuance of notification. If the winner is a minor, the scholarship will be awarded in the name of the minor's parent/legal guardian, who will be required to fulfill all requirements imposed on winners as set forth herein. Noncompliance with the official rules may result in disqualification and, at Sponsor's sole discretion, an alternate may be selected.
5. **General Conditions:** By participating, each applicant (or, if a minor, his/her parent or legal guardian) agrees: (i) to be bound by the terms of these Official Rules and the decisions of the Foundation, which shall be final and binding in all respects; (ii) to release the NAHU Education Foundation and its respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, and all of its respective officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents (collectively, the "released parties") from any liability, loss, injury or damage to applicant due in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, by participation in this scholarship program; (iii) to indemnify and hold harmless the released parties from any liability, loss, injury or damage related to applicant's participation. Released parties are not responsible for printing, typographical, technical, computer, network or other errors relating to the scholarship program, including, errors which may occur in any program materials, the administration of the scholarship program, the processing or judging of entries or the announcement of the scholarship award(s). Neither is the NAHU Education Foundation responsible for stolen, lost, late, misdirected, inaccurate, undelivered, damaged, delayed, illegible, incomplete or postage-due application entries or mail.
